OOD duties include organising sailing activity; checking SBO and helpers are available; check weather forecast; get keys; inform coastguard of numbers. Makes final decisions on activities/going out. Ensure sailors have necessary Activity Permits to cover the event/boats. Open, clean and lock up centre afterwards.

SBO duties include checking fuel; equipment; obtain 1 competent crew member, remind OOD if not contacted, top up fuel can(s) before next event. Run per Safety Boat Operating Procedure. Check/count number of personnel on the water.

All are responsible for getting a replacement if not able to carry out their duty on the particular day, and notify myself of any changes. Leaders/helpers are welcome to attend on dates not on duty! Try to fit in Blackness Dash when weather permits.
